## Keeping Kosher in Gainesville

Well I personally follow some of the rules. I stick to most of the food laws not always the food timing issues. I personally do not eat pork or any type of shellfish/seafood. I try not to mix milk and dairy but that is sometimes harder than you think. I mostly eat chicken and beef, but not kosher cuts of protein b/c they are hard to find in Gainesville. If you go to a city like New York or Miami, it's easy to find kosher restaurants and grocery stores. Here in Gainesville, the only place to get kosher food is Hillel or maybe the frozen food section of Publix.

As for the keeping kosher house, I don't 100%. Since I don't eat most unkosher foods, my house would be "semi" kosher. I don't have a separate set of dishes for milk and meat. It is hard for to keep up with these rituals. You must have two of everything. I don't have a place to store all the extra equipment. I think the idea of separating the milk and meat is great. I feel that we should not take advantage of the animal and eat the calf in its mother's milk. I really respect the animal and its ability to nourish humans and we should not take advantage of it.

As for not eating leavened foods during Passover—I follow that very strictly. I don't eat any bread, corn, corn syrup, yeast products, or beans. (There are different sets of rules for each sect/ type of Jew) You would be surprised to know how much food you cannot eat during Passover. Coke-cola makes special coke products that are corn syrup free (they have a yellow cap). The diet consists mostly of protein, fruit, and vegetables—basic and simple. Also during Passover, you must eat matzah, it's a commandment.

I also refrain from eating during Yom Kippur (the holiest day of the year). It is a 24 hour period of repentance. You are not supposed to eat and feel punished for your sins and the hunger pains remind you of all the terrible things you did throughout the year.

I don't really feel it is hard to keep the kosher laws, b/c I want to. If you want something you do it and not even think about it. Sometimes I feel that I inconvenience other people with my choice to keep "kosher". It happens mostly when you go to people's house and they serve food that I do not eat. You have to be polite and either ask for something else or not eat. I feel rude not eating something that someone has made for me. But most friends know that I keep some kosher laws and don't make food that I can't eat. Or they tell me in advance and I will bring something or myself. I also have to be selective at restaurants and ask lots of questions. I have a good idea what has pork in it, but I do ask a lot to make sure some things are pork free.

I really like the kosher laws; they make me different from most people. Every time I don't eat pork or shellfish I really appreciate that I am Jewish and I feel proud. I am sometimes the butt of jokes because I don't eat this or that, but I don't really mind. It's me and my choice—I love it!


