2. How significant is gratitude in your life?
3. What do you think of Jesus' response to the Pharisees in vs. 16-17, concerning paying taxes to Caesar? Do you see any connection between his response here and the aforementioned parable? How does Jesus' discussion of paying taxes to Caesar touch upon the idea of stewardship?
4. Read vs. 28-34. In Jesus' day there were some commandments that the rabbis wrote about and made central to what it meant to be a faithful Jew. What were those commandments? Why is it important for us to remember what the greatest commandments are? What happens when other commandments in scripture take center stage?
