## On Baptism

Through baptism in the name of Christ one experiences the radical new orientation that marks one as part of this new community. In baptism into Christ's death we die to the power of sin. In baptism we lay Christ's whole life story over the grid of our own life story. We are crucified with him. We are buried with him. We are raised with him. We live with him (Rom. 6:3-11).

In baptism we receive a new identity. We embrace a new guiding vision for our lives, a new story to tell and to live by. This new story is the story of Christ's dying and rising, and it becomes for us the lifelong story of our own repenting and being converted. In the drama of baptism one finds a new orientation to the world. Baptism symbolizes the obliteration of old distinctions, of old habits, of old racial and economic barriers. Through baptism one enters a community of equals, one where people have given up home in themselves and the old securities. "Baptized into union with him," Paul writes, "you have all put on Christ as a garment. There is no such thing as Jew and Greek, slave and free man, male and female, for you are all one person in Christ Jesus" (Gal. 3:27-28). Paul uses the same baptismal language when he speaks of growth in Christ-like character: "then put on the garments that suit God's chosen people, his own, his beloved: compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience. Be forbearing with one another, and forgiving where any of you have cause for complaint" (Col. 3:12-13).

In the powerful experience of baptism God sets us apart. We embrace a new story for our lives. Baptism is not simply the initiatory rite of Christian faith, a step on the way to salvation; rather it symbolizes the whole of that life, which is a constant dying and raising with Christ. In the faithful practice of baptism we proclaim to the world what kind of community we intend to be. We proclaim that God empowers us to be a cruciform people. [A people formed by the crucifixion.]

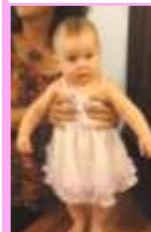
